Rebuilt in 2002, the Centre boasts a modern theatre for 250 people with a program of exciting events – from international musicians to locally produced films. Located in the centre of town on Jonson Street, the Centre is undoubtedly at the heart of Byron's entertainment and cultural life.

The Centre also provides vital community services and within the complex are several meeting rooms and key community organisations including the Byron Community Markets, Bay FM, Southern Cross

University and the Writers Centre.

2010 is an exciting year for the theatre with several major events including the Byron Arts Classic in January, the Byron Bay Film Festival in March, Voyeur Byron's Fashion Expose in October, several concerts from Byron Music Society and lots more to be announced!
